

PROCESS TO REGISTER FOR THE GLOBAL ABRSM HIGH SCORERS' CONCERT SERIES

Step 1:

Select four pieces from the ABRSM exam syllabus and email by 15th January 2022 with the full name of pieces, full name of the composers, instrument and to globalabrsmhsc@gmail.com. Please try to include more pieces from List A of the syllabus.

Step 2:

ABRSM will check your selected pieces for permission availability to be performed virtually, and you will be informed accordingly from the GHSC Nodal Office.

Step 3:

The performer will then record and perform ONE piece from the approved list.

Step 4:

The performer/ guardian will need to email the following:

- Video recording of the piece as per the guidelines in the form
- Complete registration form signed by the parent and teacher
- Scanned copy of the 2021/ 2022 Practical Exam/ Performance Grade Distinction Mark Sheet
- Email the above to globalabrsmhsc@gmail.com through We Transfer

PLEASE NOTE: The final selected list of the performers will be published in the Concert Brochure closer to the concert date. This Concert Brochure will be uploaded on media channels like the ABRSM website and Facebook Page etc. Some shortlisted applications will be stored in our files which might be used in one of the ongoing Global High Scorers' Concert series.

GUIDELINES:

- Each applicant needs to submit a clear video recording to be considered for the virtual Global ABRSM Concert.
- Performances from all ABRSM grades are welcome. Each performer will play ONE piece without repeats; to a maximum duration of 7 minutes for an upper grade. The recording should not have been used earlier for the exam or any social media channels.
- *Dress Code:* Wear clothing that is complimentary to the concert.
- *Piano:* Must be a well-tuned concert grand piano or an upright piano.
- *Recording Room:* The room should be quiet and well-lit and avoid any shadows falling on the performer.
- *Recording:* Performers and accompanists should be ready with their instruments and in position; recording should begin 5 seconds before the first note and end 5 seconds after the last note.
- *Video Specification:* Landscape orientation, MP4 format, minimum 720 Pixels with no logos or names.
- For the global experience, every concert will have around five performers per country and a maximum of fifty-five performances per concert.
- The performer should have been awarded a distinction in the 2021/ 2022 ABRSM practical/ performance grade exam.
- All accepted performers/parents and presenters understand and agree that the performer's full name, piece and composer details; and presenter's name, city and country will be displayed before each video and uploaded on platforms such as YouTube and Facebook etc. with the Global ABRSM High Scorers' Concert branding.
- Only complete registrations for the virtual concert will be accepted. Due to time constraints, complete applications will be considered on a first come first serve basis.
- The completed registration form, with a scanned copy of the exam certificate and the video recording should be sent in one email to globalabrsmhsc@gmail.com latest by **Sunday, 27th March 2022**. Incomplete registration form, sub-standard videos and late registrations will not be accepted.
